Social Time is designed to introduce children to the day's topic in a setting that gives them individualized attention from their Small Group Leaders and plenty of interaction with a small group of peers.	Large Group is designed to engage children through worship in a large group setting. Storytelling, prayer, and an innovative approach to the Bible story are always a part of this interactive time.	Small Groups are designed to help children understand how the day's topic applies to them. They'll discuss real-life experiences, interact with a close-knit group of peers, and participate in a variety of activities that appeal to different learning styles. Life application and memory verse activities, as well as prayer, are always a part of this hands-on time.

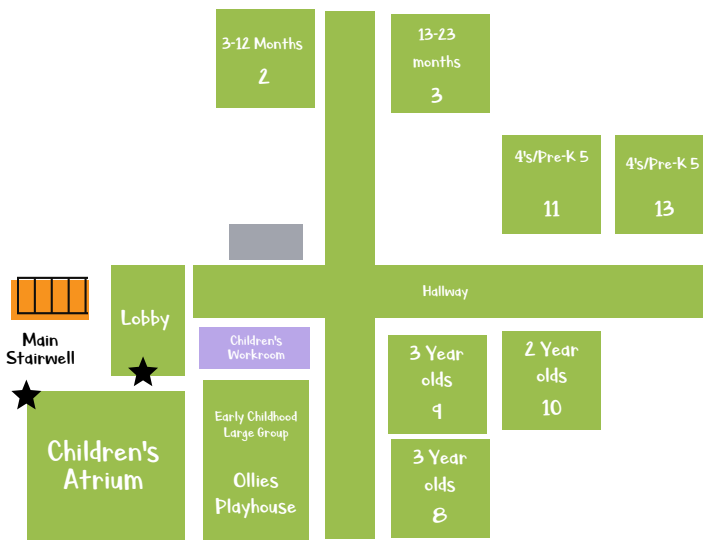

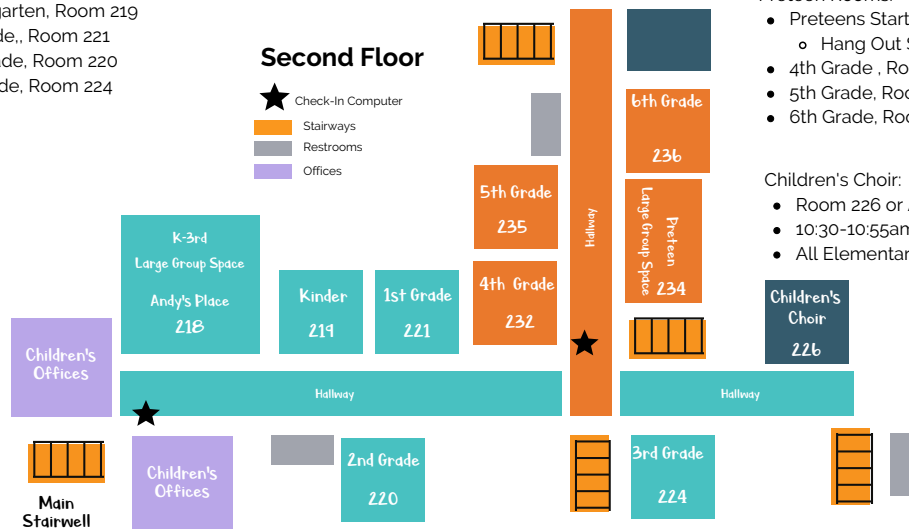
