### Shotgun Start @ 9 AM

This year, we are playing dual, side-by-side courses, and our shotgun start for all will be 9:00 a.m. Please see the attached list of teams (in no particular order) for the various courses. Note that we do not have everyone's email addresses; therefore, if you are a "captain" and signed up your team or have a teammate who may have not provided their contact information, please pass this information along to them. "Captains" have been highlighted on the spreadsheet.

Registration will open at 7:45 a.m., along with the Driving Range, Putting Green, Silent Auction and Breakfast. We ask that you **arrive by 8:40 at the latest** to ensure that all golfers are checked in prior to tee off and begin on time. We are **SOLD OUT** with 220 golfers all checking in during the same window, so please try not to leave it to the

last-minute! A few items available for purchase during registration are our shirt/mulligan package, raffle tickets, and Hasley Ball. All are invited to enjoy breakfast tacos and coffee during registration as well as check out our silent auction to place your opening bids.

## **Parking**

Player parking is at The Tribute lot (past the Old American lot). This is the lot closest to the Clubhouse. Parking attendants will be stationed to wave you in and the Club should have ample staff to assist with your golf bags. Bag Drop located at the end of the circle drive. A map is attached.

## **Tournament Rules**

### **Format**

We will be playing a 4-Person Scramble format, with a max 1 bogey on each hole.

### **Scoring**

The Club is offering live score tracking via Golf Genius, along with using regular score cards. It is not mandatory that every member of each foursome download this app to their phone, as you should be able to enter your score directly on the device in your golf cart. Each cart will also have a Leaderboard on their cart screens to update scoring throughout the tournament.

### **Opportunities to Help Scoring**

Never fear, there are a several opportunities to improve your overall scores!

1. There will be a Move Up opportunity for a suggested donation of \$100/team. Remember, the more funds raised, the more scholarships provided!
2. Also, we are proud to bring back our popular Hasley Ball, a golden golf ball named in memory of our beloved founding pastor, Robert Hasley. The Hasley Ball is good for one free putt at every hole—essentially, an extra team mulligan. It is a golden team ball and must rotate equally throughout your foursome. You may use it until you lose it; once it's gone, there are no replacements. This unique ball is available for a \$100 donation (only 1/ foursome). All proceeds will directly benefit our dual educational scholarship funds, which were dear to our "hero," Robert Hasley.

## **Hole-In-One**
